1. PURPOSE

- 1.1 To recognise outstanding contributors to the CEHL Program.

2. POLICY STATEMENT AND PRINCIPLES

2.1 STATEMENT

- 2.1.1 The CEHL Board recognises that the fundamental foundation of the Program is the contribution of co-op members to the work of their co-ops and the wider Program. This contribution, by thousands of members over many years has created this unique and successful program.

2.2 PRINCIPLES

- 2.2.1 The CEHL Board recognises outstanding contributors to the wider CEHL Program and authorises their names being added to the CEHL Honour Board.
- 2.2.2 Serving CEHL Board members are not eligible for nomination, but can be nominated following a period of CEHL Board service.
- 2.2.2 New entrants will be announced annually at the CEHL Annual General Meeting.
- 2.2.3 The Board will maintain a very high standard for inclusion on the Honour Board.

3. SCOPE

This policy applies to all honour board nominees and nominating co-op members.

4. DEFINITIONS

The Honour Board refers to the recognition of outstanding contributions to the CEHL program. The Honour Board is a permanent fixture which is located at CEHL head office, Level 1, 112 Balmain Street Richmond
